## RULES AND REGULATIONS

**Stay home if you are sick, running a fever, or have been exposed to COVID-19.**

### GENERAL

- Event will take place in parking lot at S. Southlands Parkway and E. Plaza Avenue, west of Ted's Montana Grill.
- Select Southlands restaurants and food establishments are available for take-out. Select Southlands restaurants will also offer carside delivery.
- No alcohol is permitted at the event.
- No pets allowed.
- Event will be held rain or shine. Should unsafe weather conditions arise, Southlands reserves the right to cancel the event. No refunds as this is a charitable donation.
- In accordance with state guidelines, guests will be asked to leave if they do not adhere to the Rules and Regulations.

### TICKETS

- Tickets must be purchased in advance. Tickets will go on sale weekly. Limited number available.
- Pre-paid ticket must be presented for entrance to the event - either electronic or printed copy. No tickets will be sold on-site.
- Only attendees with tickets and within vehicles may attend this event. Maximum six (6) occupants per vehicle. No walk-ins allowed.
- All tickets are general admission.

### PARKING

- Parking will start at 6:30PM. Park early to enjoy pre-movie fun! Entry to the venue will be cutoff 15 minutes prior to event time at 7:45PM. No late entry will be permitted under ANY circumstance.

- To enter venue, traffic will be directed north on S. Southlands Parkway, east on E. Plaza Avenue and into the lot. No entry permitted via southbound on S. Southlands Parkway or westbound on E. Plaza Avenue.
- Post-Event: Traffic will be directed out of the venue via E. Town Center Avenue.
- Parking will be first-come, first-served. Spaces may not be reserved.
- Cars will be parked in a manner to achieve at/or appropriate spacing and best visibility. Be considerate of vehicles/guests parked behind.
- Car engines must be turned off during event.
- Passenger vehicles only. No motorcycles, busses, party busses, RVs, limousines, bicycles, or foot traffic permitted. Tall vehicles will be directed park in the back rows.
- ADA accessible vehicles will be permitted.
- There is no re-entry once your vehicle leaves the venue premises.

### HEALTH & SAFETY

- Social distancing measures will operate in accordance with the Tri-County Health Department Guidelines. Vehicles will be spaced six feet apart.
- Guests are encouraged to remain in their vehicles. You may leave your car and sit in your own chairs / blankets if you stay within your vehicle's designated area to comply with social distancing; either in front of or beside vehicle.
- Face masks are mandatory anytime you are outside of your vehicle.
- This event is PACK IT IN / PACK IT OUT to avoid unnecessary contact. Please be respectful and don't leave trash.
